Bids will be received by the Construction Manager until **10:00 a.m. local time on April 7, 2020** at the Construction Manager's office, 6700 Highway 53, Braselton, Georgia 30517, or by email to estimating@bmandkinc.com. Bids received after the designated time will not be considered.

All bids will be evaluated and will be awarded, if it is awarded, within sixty (60) days of the bid opening. If a bidder is not selected within sixty (60) days of the bid opening, any bidder that is determined by the OWNER to be unlikely of being selected for contract award shall be released from their bid.
