

**AMENDMENT TO TATTOO ESTABLISHMENT ORDINANCE – EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 11, 2019**

**CODE SECTION TO BE AMENDED:** 32-211 Tattoo Establishments

**PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:** To permit microblading of the eyebrow in a Tattoo Establishment as defined by State Law and as permitted by State Law. To provide a definition of microblading.

**AMENDMENT LANGUAGE:**

**Section 32-11 1. (Definitions) (A) (5)**

**Microblading** - 'Microblading of the eyebrow' means a form of cosmetic tattoo artistry where ink is deposited superficially in the upper three layers of the epidermis using a handheld tool made up of needles known as a microblade to improve or create eyebrow definition, to cover gaps of lost or missing hair, to extend the natural eyebrow pattern, or to create a full construction if the eyebrows have little to no hair.

**Section 32-211 4. (Tattooing Procedure) (C) (5)** - Tattooing including the changing or repairing of previous tattoos shall not be performed on the hands below the wrist line, on the feet below the ankle, the head or face above the collar line or on the genitalia. Nor shall such tattooing be undertaken at a site of an obviously recent hypodermic injection. An exception to the area of the head or face above the collar line is microblading of the eyebrow. Microblading of the eyebrow is considered tattooing and can only be performed in an establishment that possesses a Tattoo Establishment Permit from the Town of Braselton and applicable County Environmental Health Department.
