

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BRASELTON
TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF BRASELTON, 32-201.12(d),
TO PROVIDE FOR POPULATION-BASED LIMITS ON LICENSES TO SELL
PACKAGED DISTILLED SPIRITS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING PROVISIONS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council has previously adopted regulations relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council is desirous of amending the population-based limits on licenses to sell packaged distilled spirits in light of recent population growth and additional licenses for retail sales in package form;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRASELTON, A GEORGIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Code Section 32-201.12(d) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Code Section 32-201.12(d) to provide as follows:

No license shall be issued for the retail sale in package form of distilled spirits for any business located or proposed to be located in the Town if issuance of such license shall provide for more than one (1) such licensed business for each fifteen hundred (1,500) residents of the Town, or portion thereof, based on most recent estimates of the Town's population as prepared either by the Town for that purpose or the United States Bureau of the Census in a decennial Census. Any existing license shall be exempt from the limitation set forth above.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the above are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its execution by the Mayor.
